STATEMENT OF INTEREST**

<u>Beechwood Knoll School</u> –	Accelerated Repair Program (Windows, Doors, Roof)
<u>Merrymount School</u> –	Accelerated Repair Program (Repair of Roof Section)
<u>Della Chiesa Early Childhood Center</u> –	Accelerated Repair Program (Windows)
<u>Squantum Elementary School</u> –	Core Program (Repair, renovation, or new construction of existing school)

This vote is designed to authorize the critical first step in the MSBA’s funding program for school buildings by informing MSBA about deficiencies that may exist in a local school facility and how those deficiencies inhibit the delivery of the district’s educational program.
