The campaign finance law, M.G.L. c.55, requires you to file a campaign disclosure report **Form CPF M102**, copy enclosed. The report must be filed with this office on or before **5 PM Monday, September 12, 2011**

Your report must disclose all campaign finance activity (all funds and in-kind contributions received, expenses paid and liabilities incurred) from **Jan 1, 2011 thru September 2, 2011**.


Please ensure that your report is complete before filing. Reports that do not conform with the law cannot be accepted by this office and must be returned to you for correction. Your report must include the candidate's name and **treasurer's original signature in ink**, and must be received by this office no later than the close of business on **September 12, 2011**. By law, a postmark is not acceptable.

IMPORTANT: The campaign finance law mandates that a **CIVIL PENALTY OF \$25 PER DAY UP TO \$5,000** be assessed personally against the candidate for any report that is filed after the due date and upon referral to the Office of Campaign and Political Finance. In addition, failure to file the report will subject you to referral to the Attorney General.

If you do not have a political committee organized on your behalf and you have not received any contributions, made any expenditures or incurred any liabilities during this reporting period, and you do not have a previous campaign balance, you may, if you choose, simply sign an M102-0 affidavit form stating those facts. The M102-0 form is available at this office.
