## COMMUNITY MEETING WARD 1 & WARD 2

FEMA FLOOD MAP UPDATE  
THURSDAY, JUNE 4<sup>TH</sup> AT 6:30PM

Ward One Councillor Margaret Laforest and Ward Two Councillor Brad Croall will co-host a FEMA Flood Map Update Meeting in the Central Middle School Auditorium on Thursday, June 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM. This meeting will include a presentation with specific impacts for Wards One and Two by Mr. Joseph Shea Jr., Vice President of Woodard and Curran, who has headed the City of Quincy Engineering team responsible for the successful appeal efforts undertaken to get FEMA to revise the maps.

Mr. Shea and his team will discuss the evolution of the mapping and appeal process that was undertaken and the resulting outcome which will be beneficial to many property owners in the city, by either being removed totally from the flood maps or having risk levels reduced. The presentation will review the city's schedule and process for submitting final public comments and recommended actions for property owners to take with your insurance company, and how to submit your own public comments to FEMA if you wish to. The City's FEMA team will also research specific properties one-on-one after the presentation is completed in a workshop type format.

If you received a City provided Elevation Certificate or a FEMA issued a Letter of Map Amendment (LOMA) please bring it along for the workshop discussion.
