**Questions have been asked by a potential bidder for clarification:**

*Q1. How many hours of coverage are currently being provided?*

**A1. The hours are 24/7. Current Vendor provides (2.5) 24/7 ALS and (2) 24/7**

*Q2. What is the payor mix?*

**A2. This is an Insurance question, so we can not provide an answer.**

*Q3. Can the BLS units assigned to the contract be used for transports?*

**A3. NO, all ambulances assigned to the city under the RFP are to be available for Emergency work only.**

*Q4. Is the back-up vehicle an additional vehicle staffed 24/7? Please Clarify*

**A4. Yes, it is to be housed in the City and available as the first back up if all other units are working.**

*Q5. What is a fire rehab unit? What is the staffing requirement for this unit?*


**A5. A Rehab unit is to provide FF's at a scene items for physical rehabilitation after exertion or from the weather, i.e water, wet towels, fans, misters, shelter from the cold and heat, medical attention and observation by at a minimum (1) EMT.**

*Q6. Is the contractor allowed to bill for special events or are they required to be handled as part of the contract?*

**A6. Special Events that are listed and at the Mayors and Chiefs' discretion are at the providers cost and are NOT billable.**
