1) QUESTION

Who is the current vendor?

ANSWER

The current vendor is A & A Metro, 1001 Bedford Street, Bridgewater, MA.

2) QUESTION

What is the make/model and size of buses currently used on this project?

ANSWER

There are two buses currently in use. The first is a 2006 GMC Glaval 32 passenger. The second is a 2007 Chevrolet C5500 32 passenger.

3) QUESTION

What is the current hourly rate charged?

ANSWER

The rate is \$351.00 per day.

4) **QUESTION**
