

This form is to be attached to and made part of a sidewalk opening permit issued to the Contractor who will perform the work after approval of the above departments.

The Contractor shall submit a copy or abstract of the Assessor's plan for the project to be made part of the permit and obtained from the Engineering Department.

The Contractor is required to obtain the sidewalk opening permit from the Public Works Dept. before proceeding with the actual work.

There is a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fee. One day's notice must be given to the Highway Dept. so an inspector can be assigned.

Any curbing remaining after completion of the project is to be delivered to the Municipal Garage, 55 Sea Street, Quincy, MA.

If work to be performed is within 100 feet of any traffic signal, the applicant is required to notify the City Engineer at (617) 376-1950.
