I will be hosting a Community Meeting on Wednesday, February 17, 2016 at 7:00pm, in the Cafeteria at 500 Victory Road, Marina Bay in reference to a proposal from Scannell Properties to subdivide and convert the existing Boston Scientific Corporation warehouse building located at 500 Commander Shea Boulevard to a FedEx Ground Distribution Facility.
