

## **Flu Clinic Update**

**Public Flu Clinic Schedule for H1N1:** Our public clinics, for H1N1 flu vaccine are open to Quincy residents 10 (ten) years of age and older. Children between the ages of ten (10) and eighteen (18) **MUST** be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Our Clinic schedule for H1N1 will be as follows:

Wednesday, January 20,

Thursday, January 21 and

Friday, January 22<sup>nd</sup> from 2:00 to 4:00 pm

At the Kennedy Center, 440 East Squantum Street, Quincy



We will also hold an evening clinic on

Thursday, January 21, 2010

From 5:00 to 8:00 PM

at the Kennedy Center, 440 East Squantum Street:

Residents will be asked to fill in a brief vaccination administration record form. We also ask that you wear clothing that allows quick and ready access to your upper arm for the administration of the vaccine (flu shot).

The Quincy Health Department has a limited amount of seasonal flu vaccine remaining. Flu Clinics will be scheduled as follows for Quincy residents at the **Kennedy Center, 440 East Squantum Street:**

Every Monday in January, from 9:30 – 11:00 AM and 2:00 – 3:30 PM , until the supply of vaccine is depleted.

These clinics will be for Seasonal Flu Vaccine Only, for Quincy residents- Age 18 and above.

Any resident with Medicare or seniors should bring their insurance cards. We are allowed to bill for administration of the vaccine.

The Quincy Health Department has received a small amount of preservative-free H1N1 and seasonal flu vaccine. This vaccine is for pregnant women **ONLY**. It will be administered by appointment only. Please call 617-376-1285 between the hours of 9:00-11:00 AM and 2:00-4:00 PM to schedule an appointment.
