CHAPTER 62C. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS RELATIVE TO STATE TAXATION

Chapter 62C: Section 49A Certification of compliance with tax laws as prerequisite to obtaining license or governmental contract

Section 49A. (a) Any person applying to any department, board, commission, division, authority, district or other agency of the commonwealth or any subdivision of the commonwealth, including a city, town or district, for a right or license to conduct a profession, trade or business, or for the renewal of such right or license, shall certify upon such application, under penalties of perjury, that he has complied with all laws of the commonwealth relating to taxes, reporting of employees and contractors, and withholding and remitting child support. Such right or license shall not be issued or renewed unless such certification is made.

(b) No contract or other agreement for the purposes of providing goods, services or real estate space to any of the foregoing agencies shall be entered into, renewed or extended with any person unless such person certifies in writing, under penalties of perjury, that he had complied with all laws of the commonwealth relating to taxes, reporting of employees and contractors, and withholding and remitting child support.


(c) Any such agency, which has been notified by the commissioner pursuant to section forty-seven A that a person who holds a license or certificate of authority issued by such agency or who has agreed to furnish goods, services or real estate space to such agency has neglected or refused to file any returns or to pay any tax required under this chapter and that such person has not filed in good faith a pending application for abatement of such tax or a pending petition before the appellate tax board contesting such tax or has been penalized pursuant to section 9 of chapter 62E for failure to comply with the provisions under said chapter 62E relating to reporting of employees and contractors, or has been penalized pursuant to paragraph (3) of subsection (f) of section 12 of chapter 119A for failure to comply with the provisions under said chapter 119A relating to withholding and remitting child support, shall refuse to reissue, renew or extend such license, certificate of authority, contract or agreement until the agency receives a certificate issued by the commissioner that the person is in good standing with respect to any and all returns due and taxes payable to the commissioner as of the date of issuance of said certificate, including all returns and taxes referenced in the initial notification or, if the licensee has been penalized for failure to comply with the provisions relating to reporting of employees and contractors under chapter 62E or withholding and remitting child support under chapter 119A, a certificate issued by the commissioner that the licensee is in compliance with said provisions.

(d) Any person who owns or leases a motor vehicle or trailer that is required to be registered in the commonwealth under chapter 90 and improperly registers the motor vehicle or trailer in another state or misrepresents the place of garaging of the motor vehicle or trailer in another city or town, shall be considered in violation of laws of the commonwealth relating to taxes under chapter 60A, chapter 64H or chapter 64I. The right, license or contract provided for in subsections (a) and (b) shall not be issued or renewed until the person or business entity has paid all taxes due at the time of application for such right, license or contract.

(e) Any person who, for the purpose of evading payment of a tax pursuant to chapters 59 to 64J, inclusive, willfully makes and subscribes any return, form, statement or other document pursuant to subsection (a), (b) or (d) that contains or is verified by a written declaration that is made under the penalties of perjury, and that contains information that he does not believe to be true and correct as to every matter material to his compliance with all laws of the commonwealth relating to taxes, shall be subject to section 73.



The City Of Quincy acting on behalf of the Department Of Public Works will receive sealed bids for **Frame Restoration** on (5)-five all wheel drive snow until **11:15 AM** local time **Thursday, JULY 24, 2014**, in the offices of The Purchasing Agent, City Hall, 2nd Floor, 1305 Hancock Street, Quincy, Massachusetts 02169, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The City has **(2)-two 1986 Mack trucks** model RM6854X (Truck # 74 & # 75) all wheel drive, **(3)-three Auto car model** ACL42b (Truck # 80, #81 & #82) all wheel drive. All bid prices must include pick up and delivery of all five trucks to, 55 Sea St. Quincy, MA. 02169.

The City of Quincy is exempt from sales tax. A certificate of exemption will be furnished upon request. The following details explain what is expected for said repairs.

All trucks can be seen at 55 Sea St. Quincy MA. Between 7am and 3 pm Mon- Fri.

The City of Quincy reserves the right to accept, or to reject, any bid, in whole or in part, which they deem not to be in the best interest of the City of Quincy.

The City of Quincy will not be responsible any bids received omitting addenda acknowledgement.

SCOPE OF WORK

To be done on all vehicles

- ♦ All spreaders must be removed and stored for reinstallation.
- ♦ New wood cross members will be installed on all spreaders.
- ♦ Hopper grates on all spreaders will be blasted, painted and sealed.
- ♦ Truck frames shall be blasted, painted and sealed.
- ♦ All wheels will be taken off blasted, painted and sealed.
- ♦ Under cabs shall be blasted, painted and sealed.
- ♦ New sub frames for spreaders with 18” cat walks on both sides and a ladder on left side for top access.
- ♦ Plow frames and bumpers shall be blasted, painted and sealed.
- ♦ The new sub frames and cat walks will all be blasted, painted and sealed.
- ♦ Sub frames shall be fabricated out of rectangular steel tubing sealed at each end.
- ♦ Spreaders will be reinstalled with new tie down chains, and new hydraulic lines from the cab on back to the sander.
- ♦ New junction boxes will be installed and sealed on all trucks.
- ♦ All lighting on trucks will be repaired or replaced with plastic or noncorrosive parts (that includes lights on spreaders).
- ♦ Wiring will be replaced as needed and sealed as needed (on all vehicles)

Additional work to be done on Truck # 80, 81 & 82

- ♦ Truck# 80 needs a replacement grate that would have to be fabricated to match existing grates.
- ♦ Truck# 80, 81, 82 need cross members repaired or fabricated (2nd cross member from rear).
- ♦ Truck# 80, 81, 82 need floor boards reinforced before painting and sealing.
- ♦ All frame rails, plow frames and bumpers shall be painted black.

- ♦ All sub frames will be constructed (similar to truck# 74, 75.) Existing rear fenders will be hung on new sub frames.
- ♦ Sub frames will have steel blocks welded on each side of the spreaders, so they don't slide side ways (similar to truck#74, 75).

Additional work to be done Mack Truck # 74 & 75

- ♦ The two Mack trucks shall have both front fenders fabricated to match existing fenders.
- ♦ Paint on top of fenders will match truck cab (red).
- ♦ They shall be made out of steel similar or greater than existing ones and their fenders will be blasted, painted and sealed from top and bottom.
