Special Provisions Relating to Work Funded Under American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

Brewer's Corner Neighborhood Improvement Project

With respect to funds made available to State or local governments for infrastructure investments under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Pub. L. 111-5, Thomas P. Koch, Mayor of the City of Quincy, has certified by acceptance of Award Number DE-SC0003078 under the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) program that the infrastructure investment described herein has received the full review and vetting required by law and that the Mayor accepts responsibility that the infrastructure investment is an appropriate use of taxpayers dollars.

Description of Investment: Design and installation of LED traffic signals at intersection of Copeland, Water, Granite and Smith Streets. The EECBG investment is a component of an overall neighborhood improvement project. Other core public improvements include sidewalk and curb reconstruction, ADA-compliant ramps, roadway resurfacing and new street trees.
