

Mooring Permit Instructions

In accordance with the Ordinances of the City of Quincy, all vessels, boats, and watercraft habitually moored/docked in the waters of Quincy are required to display a City Of Quincy mooring permit. There is no charge for this permit. These permits are valid from July 1 to June 30 of the following year. A [mooring permit application](#) must be submitted each year to receive a permit sticker.

If you received a permit but have not affixed it to the port side of your vessel, please do so. If you submitted a City of Quincy mooring permit application and did not receive a mooring permit sticker, please email us at quincypolicemarineunit@quincyma.gov or call the Quincy Police Marine Unit at 617-745-5896. Please include the vessel's registration number, the name of the Marina, Yacht Club, or mooring location, as well as your name and phone number.

Any person who places a vessel in the waters of Quincy for the first time is required to file a completed Massachusetts tax form [2BE-1](#) at the [Quincy Assessors Office](#) within 10 days of entry into Quincy waters. The assessor's office can be reached by calling 617-376-1170. Upon submission of this form and submission of a City of Quincy mooring permit application to the Quincy Police Marine Unit, a mooring permit will be issued.
