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### HISTORICAL COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

#### Public Hearings:

- 1. 1200 Hancock St. Citizens Bank:** The Applicant was represented by Carol Bugbee of Philadelphia Sign Co. Ms. Bugbee went through the application and indicated all present signs were remaining as they presently are and the only significant change was to be the blue stripe at the bottom of the signs. She also noted that the application called for one (1) wall sign, when in fact it was to be two (2) wall signs as presently exists over the front and rear entrances.

A motion to accept the proposal as submitted was offered by Member Foley and seconded by Member Trepanier. There was no discussion on the motion and was unanimously accepted.

#### Other Business:

- 1. Communications:** Chairman Ricci referred to a letter with supporting documentation that was addressed to him. The letter requested support of the Souther Tide Mill. Chairman Ricci read a letter he drafted to support the study to save/restore the building. Members unanimously supported the letter. However, there was discussion on what seems to be a lack of direction for the project and that the City should begin to identify a goal to set the project on a workable track.

2. Mr. Verenis indicated that Ms. Kara Chisholm of the Planning Department would like to address the Members at its February meeting on the status of the Hancock Cemetery.
