Spectra Energy's Proposed Weymouth Compressor Station

Dear Neighbor:

Ward Two Councillor Brad Croall and I have been working with our colleagues in Weymouth and attending all of the public meetings being held on Spectra Energy's Proposed Weymouth Compressor Station. We have officially submitted comments expressing our opposition with the location, environment and coastal concerns, environmental justice and public safety to the Energy Facilities Siting Board, the review board charged with ensuring a reliable energy supply for the Commonwealth with a minimum impact on the environment at the lowest possible cost. At the September 8th City Council meeting Councillor Croall and I also introduced a resolve opposing the site location by Spectra Energy for the Atlantic Bridge Project and strongly urging Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to encourage the applicant to find a less populated alternative location for their application which the City Council unanimously passed that evening.

We understand that many residents may have questions and concerns regarding this proposal and we have scheduled a Public Information Session on Wednesday, October 21st at the Snug Harbor Community School located at 333 Palmer Street. Ward Councillors and representatives from Spectra Energy will be available from 5:30 pm to 7:30 pm in the gymnasium to answer questions and concerns.
