NOTICE OF JOINT PUBLIC HEARING 2012-107

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the provisions of MGL Ch. 40A, Section 5, the Quincy City Council and Quincy Planning Board will hold a joint public hearing on June 25, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, Quincy City Hall, 1305 Hancock Street, to consider the following:

In Title 17 Zoning Chapter under Section 8.1 Flood Plain Overlay District (FPOD) by deleting Section 8.1 in its entirety and inserting a revised Section 8.1 which is substantially a rewording and renumbering of same that includes the following changes:

1. Amend Section 8.1.2 – Location: The adoption of the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) floodplain management measures that satisfy 44 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Section 60.3 (d) and (e) of the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) regulations and adoption of the latest FEMA Floodplain Maps.
2. Amend Section 8.1.9 – Special Permit (new number 8.1.7): The Zoning Board of Appeals will no longer act as the Special Permit Granting Authority (SPGA). The Planning Board and the Director of Inspectional Services shall act as the SPGA. All Special Permits/Findings shall be subject to the approval of the Quincy Conservation Commission.
