

## **Public Flu Clinic Schedule- Fall, 2010**

Our public flu clinics are scheduled as follows:

▲ Our first clinic date, is Sunday, November 14, 2010, from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM at the following two locations,

-Quincy High School, Cafeteria, 52 Coddington Street

Enter through the Rotunda Entrance on Russell Park. Parking is available in the Quincy High School Parking Lot on Russell Park

AND

-North Quincy High School Atrium, 316 Hancock Street, Quincy, MA 02171

Enter through the main entrance.

These clinics are open to Quincy residents 9 (nine) years of age and older. Children between the ages of nine (9) and eighteen (18) MUST be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

▲ Our second public clinic date will be:

Tuesday, November 30, 2010, from 9:30 to 11:00 AM. This will be held at the Quincy Elks, 254 Quarry Street. This clinic is for residents 18 and older.

▲ Starting November 1, public clinics will also be held each Monday from 2-4 PM at the Quincy Health Department, 440 East Squantum Street. These clinics will be open to residents 9 years of age and older. Children between 9 and 18 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

We also ask that you wear clothing that allows quick and ready access to your upper arm for the administration of the influenza vaccine (flu shot).

Seniors should bring all of their medicare and medicare supplemental health insurance cards, so we may submit for administration reimbursement. There is no cost for the flu shot. Women who are pregnant should have a note from their Doctor.
