Chairman Shea announced the following items will be heard at a later date.

Agenda 3. Hearing regarding the request of Blue Hills Towing Co., d/b/a/ Light 'Em Up, 159 Brook Road for a permit to store gas in the tanks of 50 vehicles. Thomas Wuesterfeld.

Agenda 4. Hearing regarding the request of Blue Hills Towing Co, d/b/a Light 'Em Up, 258 Willard Street for a Garage Repair License. Thomas Wuesterfeld.

Agenda 1. Hearing regarding the request of Interfaith Social Services, 105 Adams Street for their 37th Annual Walk, Saturday April 16, 2011. Ms. Bettyanne Lang, present.
