Agenda 1. Hearing regarding the request of Brian Sullivan for an extension of Premise @ Sully's, 28 Chestnut Street, for the 82nd Anniversary, Saturday June 11, 2016 from Noon to Midnight on the front sidewalk. Brian Sullivan is present. Motion: Drew Scheele, second Jay Duca all in favor.

Agenda 2. hearing regarding the request of the Central Baptist Church for a Special Use Permit for a Block Party @ 29 Foster Street, Saturday April 30, 2016. Teresa Bardon & Doug Bruce. Teresa Bardon present. This is a non-alcoholic event; plans are to close Foster Street for a few hours. This is a traditional block party. Hours 11-2PM. Motion Drew Scheele, second Jay Duca. Agenda 3. Hearing regarding the request of Point Webster Middle School for a Special Use Permit for the annual Point Webster 5k Great Race Saturday April 30, 2016. Ms. Barbara Campbell, present. Agenda 4. Hearing regarding the request of Quincy T Food Store, Inc, d/b/a Coffee Pot, 247 Atlantic St. for a Common Victualer License. Dineshkumar A. Patel, present. (Danny). This is the former Coffee Break Café. He will now get a food service license from the health dept. for the new Coffee Pot. Jay Duca: signage is in violation and Ken Burke has visited, Jay will not vote today he asked for a continuation until the signs are no longer in violation, Also Deputy Jackson has an issue with the ansul system and the emergency lights need repair. Agenda 5. Continued hearing regarding the application for a new CV All Alcohol Restaurant License of Pho Pasteur, Inc. d/b/a Pho Pasteur, 1462 Hancock St. Atty. Ed. Fleming, present with applicant. This has been continued due to dumpster conditions in the alley.
They will have one dumpster company, Waste Management. All businesses have met (5 operators) and agreed.. All other information is complete for ABCC approval. This is the first pouring license for the downtown Chapter. 111. There are certain restrictions, he will need to hold the license for 3 years or turn it in to the Board. Motion to grant the request made by Commissioner Scheele, second Jay Duca. All in favor.

Agenda 6. Hearing regarding status of the CV All Alcohol Restaurant License issued to H&L Restaurant, Inc. d/b/a Crystal Palace, 706-708 Hancock St. Mr. Binh Vuong. No Show. There has been a report submitted by Lt. Turowski who noted the restaurant has been closed for weeks. H&L was notified. Mr. Vuong notified Commissioner Scheele that he has some health issues. He is recuperating and plans to return. Per Chapter 138 § 77 he needs to use the license.
