The Board of License Commissioners of the City of Quincy met in Council Chambers on Tuesday, December 7, 2010, at 4:00 P.M. with Chairman Joseph P. Shea presiding. Also present, Police Chief Paul Keenan, Inspectional Services Director James Duca, Health Commissioner Andrew Scheele, Fire Chief Joseph Barron, Lt. Peter Turowski, Det. Leo Coppens.

Agenda 1. Hearing regarding the request of the Hough's Neck Community Congregational Church, 310 Manet Ave. for a One-day Wine & Malt License for the 2nd Annual Chili-Cook Off, Saturday January 29, 2011 from 2-5 PM. Ms. Jennifer Logue, present. Motion to grant the request made by Commissioner Scheele, second Chief Keenan. All in favor.

Agenda 2. Continued hearing of November 30, 2010 regarding the request of Packaging Center, Inc. d/b/a Stop & Shop, 65 Newport Ave. for a Change of Manager, from Mark DePasquale to Keith Royer. Mr. Royer, present. Motion to grant the request made by Commissioner Scheele, second Chief Keenan. All in favor.

Agenda 3. Continued hearing of November 30, 2010 regarding the request of Quincy Mini Mart & Gas, Inc. d/b/a Furnace Brook Gas & Convenience, 507 Furnace Brook Parkway for a CV & Gas Repair License. Osberto A. Rodriguez, Manager, present with current owner Maryanne Dao. Chairman Shea reviewed the hearing of November 30, 2010. On the advise of City Solicitor Jim Timmins Director Duca motion to continue today's hearing until the first meeting in January 2011, second Director Scheele, all in favor. At that the Board will determine if the parties involved have resolved all differences.

Agenda 4. Hearing regarding the police report from Lt. Peter Turowski, Liquor Inspector re: violation of MGL 138 §34: Sale of alcohol to a minor @ Quick 6 Discount Liquors, 603 Washington St. on November 24, 2010. Rajinder Kaur, Manager & Attorney Jonathan Hurley present. Lt. Turowski read his report of the incident. Chairman Shea noted this is the third violation since 2008. Councilor Hurley apologized for the licensee adding this was a mistake, the 16 year old used his brothers ID's. Chief Keenan noted the 16 year old to be "baby faced". Attorney Hurley argued that the ID and picture of the 16 year old placed side by side looked similar. Chief Barron added he has seen too many horrific results of underage drinking and using a passport as an ID from a local resident should have raised suspicion. Commissioner Scheele questioned how many passports are used as ID, Mr. Sing stated "not that many". Commissioner Scheele noted this is the 3rd violation and maybe it's time to revoke and suspend for 10 Friday or Saturday nights. Attorney Hurley stated "they blew it" but 10 Fridays is severe. Chief Keenan motioned to suspend the license for 5 days, second Director Duca. Commissioner Scheele motioned to amend the motion to suspend for 10 days and place 5 days on file for one year from the November 24, 2010 date. Any subsequent violations would cause the additional 5 days to also be served. Chairman Shea took the following vote: Motion to grant the 10-day suspension with 5 days placed on file for one year, 5 days to be served, January 6, January 7, January 8, January 14, January 15, 2011.
