Chairman Shea opened the hearing at 4:00 P.M.

Agenda 1. Hearing regarding the status of the CV All Alcoholic License issued to Tidelands Corp. d/b/a Louis Crossing, 1269 Sea Street. Mr. John Boyd, Manager and his daughter Susan Boyd, present. Chairman Shea reviewed the renewal process and read a letter from the Board hand delivered and accepted by Louis Crossing on December 30, 2010. The letter explained MGL 62C Sec. 49: Compliance of Tax Laws. Chairman Shea noted the law is straight forward for everyone. Mr. Boyd agreed to see the City Treasurer/Collector and comply with the MGL. Commissioner Scheele motioned to continue the hearing, keep Louis Crossing closed until he is compliant with the law. Chief Keenan seconded and noted if Mr. Boyd is compliant on Wednesday, January 5, 2011 a hearing next week will not be needed. All in favor.
