The Board met in Council Chambers Tuesday, July 14, 2009 @ 4:00pm with Chairman Joseph P. Shea presiding, also present Vice Chair Commissioner Andrew Scheele, Inspectional Services Director Joseph Duca, Police Chief Paul Keenan, Fire Chief Joseph Barron & Liquor Inspector Lt. Peter Turowski, QPD.

Mr. Neil McCole, Present. Motion to grant the requests made by Commissioner Scheele, second Director Duca. All in favor.

Request of ING, One Heritage Drive for a One-day Wine & Malt License for an Employee Function, Tuesday, July 14, 2009. Ms. Janet Denneen, present. Motion to grant the requests made by Commissioner Scheele, second Chief Keenan. All in favor.

**Agenda 1.** Hearing regarding the request of Velocity Dance Co., 37 Billings Road, for a Dancing School License. Mr. Vincent Famador & Erica Limoncelli Famador present. Chairman Shea reviewed the application noting all inspections are complete. Director Duca confirmed Zoning Board approval on June 23, 2009. The school will offer Tap, Ballet, Hip Hop & Irish Step Dancing for preschool to adult, with the main focus on children. Motion to grant the requests made by Commissioner Scheele, second Director Duca. All in favor.

**Agenda 2.** Hearing regarding the request of Club 58, 58 Ross Way for an Extension of Premise for July 17 & 18, 2009. Mr. James Pansullo present. The request is for outside during the Annual Sidewalk Sale. Motion to grant the request made by Commissioner Scheele, second Chief Keenan. All in favor.

**Agenda 3.** Hearing regarding complaints received regarding the operation of super Clean Car Wash, 2 Miller Street. Mr. Anthony Ruscito, Manager & Attorney Donald Orkin present. Ward 4 Councillor James Davis requested the hearing to discuss noise complaints he has received from neighbors. Councillor Davis explained a large bay constructed last year and the conversion to an automatic car wash has brought complaints from residents of the Drohan Apartments and abutting Miller Street residents. Complaints range from the new automatic bay being as loud as a Jet Engine, with decibels as high as 91 also the vacuum cleaner and customers boom boxes blaring. Also speaking, Richard Sheehan, 170 Copeland Street, stated since the new machine has been installed the noise is constant from early morning to late night, 7 days a week. Attorney Orkin noted Mr. Ruscito was never been contacted. Director Duca will review permits for the bay and questioned the vacuum cleaner. Mr. Ruscito stated the vacuum was there when he purchased the business, he replaced one and noted the older one is louder. Chairman Shea reviewed ownership noting the Board was not aware of the sale from Laco Enterprises to Mr. Ruscito, he asked that the proper applications for licensing be completed and returned to the License Board office. The prior owners held Garage/Repair and Gas/Repair License. The Board asked Mr. Ruscito to adjust the hours of operation to open @7AM and close @ 11 PM, he agreed. Attorney Orkin offered to have a meeting with neighbors. On the motion of Commissioner Scheele, second Chief Keenan the Board voted to continue the hearing until August 25, 2009.

**Agenda 4.** Hearing regarding the request of Captain Fishbone's, 332 Victory Road for a license for outside Entertainment. Present were owners Matthew & Denise Reneghan. Mr. Reneghan stated he would like live outside entertainment on Friday & Saturday nights on the Café located on the Boardwalk. Chairman Shea reviewed all stipulations at Marina Bay and noted Captain Fishbone's to have a no speaker stipulation. A letter received from Carolyn Bowe was read into the record by the Chairman. Area residents present were: Ms. Diane Holbrook, 2001 Marina Drive & Mr. James Cadigan, 2001 Marina Drive who asked that decibel levels and the ongoing issues of noise be addressed. Speaking in favor were Maureen & Frank Glynn, 1001 Marina Bay. Director Duca noted Mayor Koch has asked him for sound levels at Marina Bay to create a base level and he would not be in favor at this time or vote not knowing the outcome. Chief Keenan added he also could not support but will keep an open mind and vote once the sound levels are determined, Chairman Shea also stated he will vote when parameters are established. Motion to deny the request in the Café portion for outside entertainment made by Director Duca, second Commissioner Scheele. All in favor.

The Board accepted the minutes and waived reading of the previous hearing.

The hearing adjourned 5:40 PM
