**Agenda 1.** Request of St. Mary's Parish, 115 Crescent St. for a One-day liquor license, May 21, 2011. Judi Pekkinen, present. Talk of the Town will do the light refreshments. With no other questions Commissioner Scheele motioned to grant the request, second Chief Keenan. All in favor.

**Agenda 2.** Hearing regarding the request of Bill Dunn Sr., for a One-day permit to hold the 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Bill Dunn Jr. Memorial Road Race, June 25, 2011.
