




Office of the City Clerk
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The City Council of the City of Quincy met on Monday, December 12, 2011 in the City Hall Council Chambers with City Council President Kevin F. Coughlin presiding. Present were Councilors Finn, Gutro, Keenan, Laforest, McFarland, McNamee, Orlando, and Palmucci.

President Coughlin opened the meeting with a moment of silence in recognition of all the men and women serving our nation in the military, both at home and abroad.

Chris Walker, Director of Policy and Information, Mayor's Office, addressed the Council and provided background information on setting the tax rate, as well as the goals for the future.

#2011-192 – Reduction of the Long Term Debt Interest Line by \$54,844.32 to be credited to Account 0170059-590151, \$44,724.93, Account 0170059-590153, \$10,119.89. Councilor Keenan moved passage subject to verification, and to grant the administration the authority to make a word change if needed. On the motion made by Councilor Keenan, seconded by Councilor McFarland with a recommendation it ought to pass, the order passed by a 9-0 roll call vote.

#2011-193 – Appropriation of \$617,337.00 to FY 2012 various accounts to be transferred from FY 2011 encumbrances and various accounts. Councilor Keenan moved passage of the order as presented. On the motion made by Councilor Keenan, seconded by Councilor McFarland with a recommendation it ought to pass, the order passed by a 9-0 roll call vote.

#2011-194 – Reduction of Health Insurance Expenditures by \$1,400,000.00. Councilor Keenan moved passage of the order as presented. On the motion made by Councilor Keenan, seconded by Councilor McFarland with a recommendation it ought to pass, the order passed by a 9-0 roll call vote.


#2011-195 – Transfer of \$909,062.81 from Hotel-Motel Tax to Debt Service. Councilor Keenan moved substitution of the order such that it reads a total of \$908,749.81 is hereby transferred from Hotel-Motel Tax to Debt Service in the following manner, all in favor. Councilor Keenan moved passage of the order as substituted. On the motion made by Councilor Keenan, seconded by Councilor McFarland with a recommendation it ought to pass, the order passed by a 9-0 roll call vote.

#2011-196 – Appropriation of \$4,534,356 from free cash to reduce the overlay deficit of \$2,092,607.00, and to reduce the snow and ice account deficit by \$2,441,749.00. Councilor Keenan moved passage of the order as presented. On the motion made by Councilor Keenan, seconded by Councilor McFarland with a recommendation it ought to pass, the order passed by a 9-0 roll call vote.

#2011-190 – Adoption of various percentages of local tax levy to be borne by each class of real and personal property for FY 2012. Councilor Keenan moved amendment of the order as follows: reference to FY 2013 be amended to reflect 2012, change date to July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, all in favor. Councilor Keenan moved passage of the order as amended. On the motion made by Councilor Keenan, seconded by Councilor McFarland with a recommendation it ought to pass, the order passed by a 9-0 roll call vote.

#2011-191 – Adopting residential factor for FY 2012. He moved the order be amended to reflect this is for FY 2012, with dates of July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012 in paragraphs 1 and 3, all in favor. Councilor Keenan moved passage of the order as amended. On the motion made by Councilor Keenan, seconded by Councilor McFarland with a recommendation it ought to pass, the order passed by a 9-0 roll call vote.
