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HISTORICAL COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

February 24, 2014

Chairman Ricci called the meeting to order at 7:10 pm. A motion to accept the Minutes of the January 27, 2014 meeting was made by Member Fitzgerald, second by Member Ricci. All were in favor.

Public Hearings:

There were no Public Hearings scheduled

- 1.** A presentation to the Members on the status of the Hancock Cemetery was given by Kara Chisholm of the Planning Department. Ms. Chisholm is the Project Manager for the restoration of this phase of the marker restoration in the Hancock Cemetery.

She indicated that the bidding process had concluded and a preservationist had been selected and work will begin in mid-March. She expects 66% of the work to be completed by June 20 and the final 33% to be completed by August 31. Tamara Conde will be conducting the field work. Halvorsen Design was acting as advisers to the project.

The members discussed the financing of the project. Costs are determined to be \$89.1K for the preservationist and \$16.5K to Halvorsen as advisors. The CPC funds of \$80K more than covered the 50% required match by the MHC. They then awarded \$33K to the project. Total funds available are \$113K. We anticipated a residual of approximately \$7K.

Members then began looking ahead and will strategize as to how to go to the next step in the plan originally designed by Halvorsen Design.

Meeting adjourned on a motion by Member Hunt, second by Member Fitzgerald
at 7:50 pm.
