As an applicant for a street-closing permit to hold a block party, I understand and accept that I am assuming certain responsibilities. The city of Quincy has enacted ordinances relative to drinking alcohol in public, which make it an offense to drink alcohol upon any public way. The commonwealth of Massachusetts has also enacted laws relating to alcohol and its consumption – particularly relating to minors. If anyone supplies alcohol to a minor, or if minors possess or transport alcohol publicly, they are subject to arrest. The city also has ordinances relating to excessive noise – these ordinances apply to music when it is played over a loudspeaker, whether recorded or via a live performance.

The city, should it grant this permit, does so with the hope that all enjoy the company of their neighbors. However, public officials will still be required to enforce all municipal ordinances and state statutes, and will do so as appropriate. We require all applicants to make an appointment with the Quincy Police Department to share information – you, about your party; and the Police will inform you in more detail about your obligations, and the laws reviewed, above. As the applicant, you are required to make and attend this appointment, and to share with all your neighbors and guests the importance of appropriate and lawful behavior.
